

11 Suggestions For a Career in Microfinance

The following are recommendations to get a job in international development broadly and microfinance in particular.

- 1. Learn or already speak a foreign language
- 2. Start while in school. Make use of student status and time now
- 3. Work 2 + years in a developing country and/or with a hard-to-serve population
- 4. Start for free. Amortized over your career, this 'cost' is negligible
- 5. Work for a bank or in finance to get a foundation and technical tools
- 6. Do background research BEFORE talking to people
- 7. Consider organization size & type big/small, formal/informal, donor, private, etc.
- 8. Who do you know and who can you access in your network? (Professors, alumni, family, friends, contacts, etc.)
- 9. Make a list of the top 5 organizations and jobs you want. Go after those first
- 10. Be tenacious, but polite. If you don't hear back from someone, try again
- 11. Be true to yourself and what you want to do for work on a daily basis
