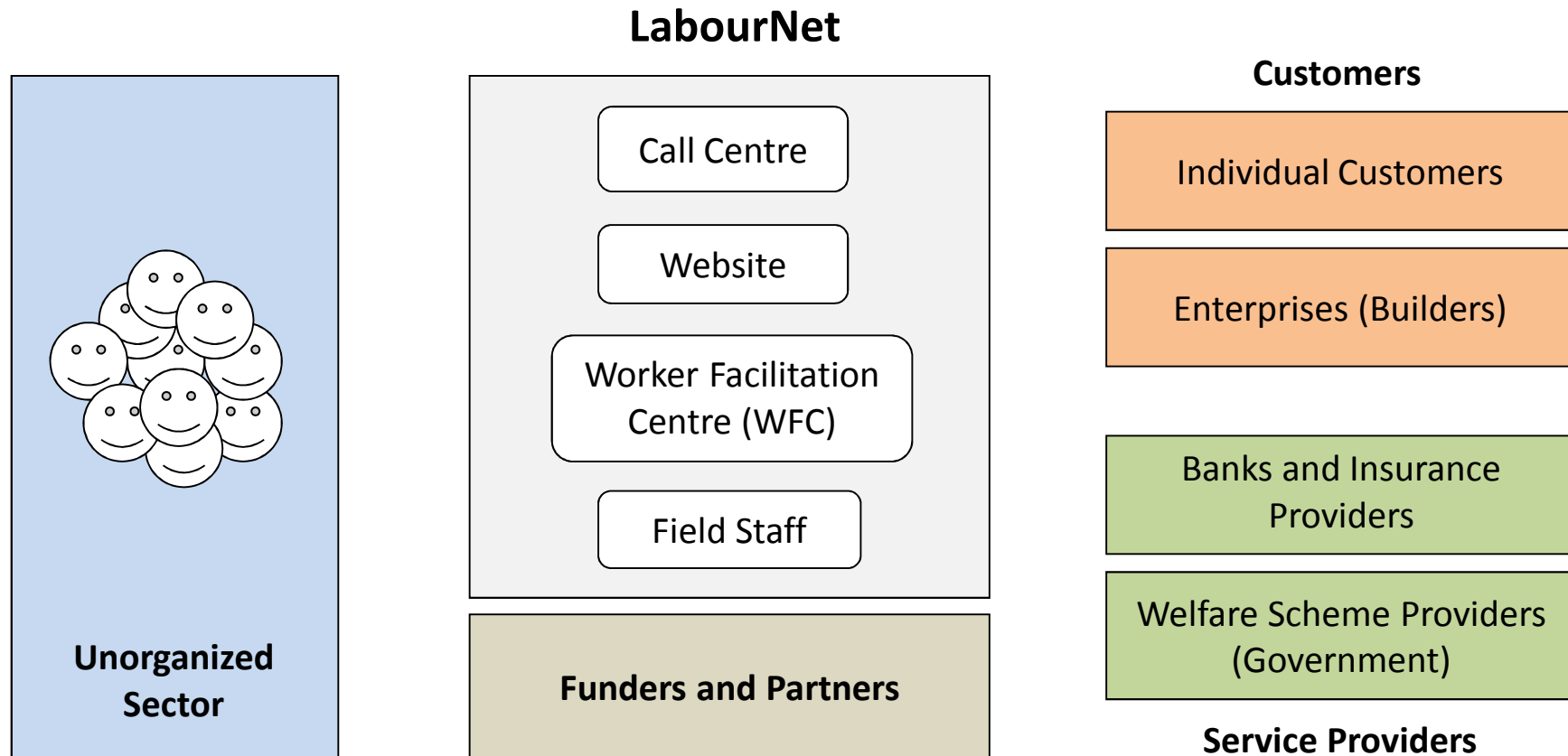

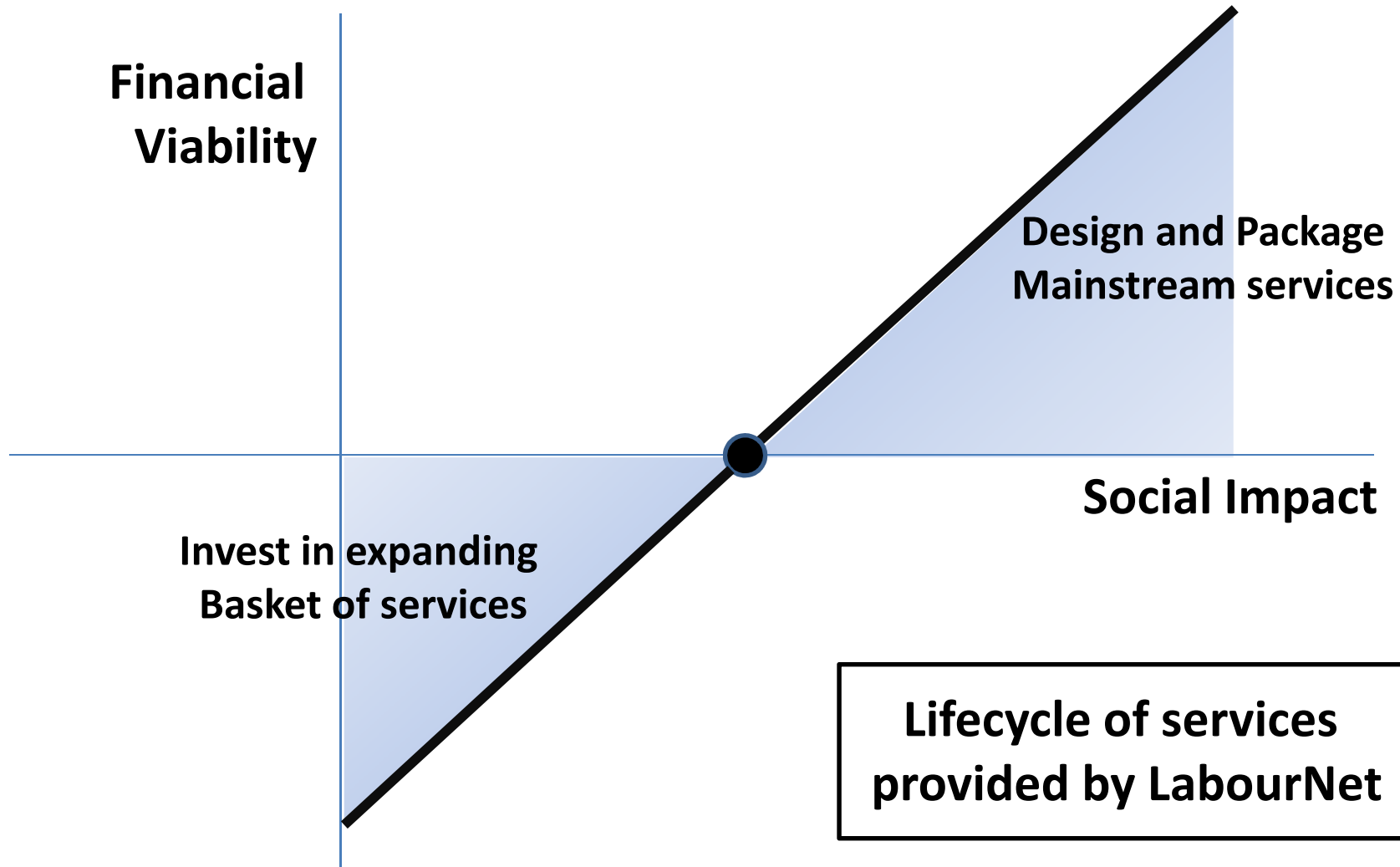


Results

Through its 8 Worker Facilitation Centres, LabourNet impacts the lives of over 36,000 workers

Service	Results
Worker registration	36,000
Bank accounts	12,000
Health Checkups	25000 – 26000
Hospitalization Insurance	300 workers
Accident Insurance	36000 (along with welfare schemes of Haryana welfare board)
Children in Crèches	262
Trainings	5300 (including 1800 MES Certification and 400 BOSCH and ITC training certification)
Training videos	9 videos in Hindi, Tamil, Telugu and Kannada
