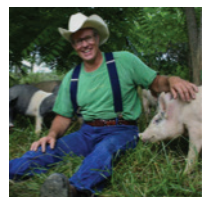

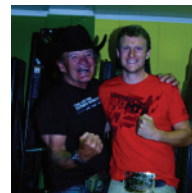


Slow Money Meets Bluegrass

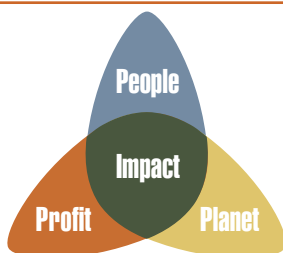

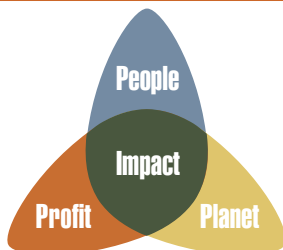
